Eligibility:

This exhibition is open to artists in Central Iowa. The show will be classified and hung in two groups: Professional and Nonprofessional.

The Professional Artist:

- Artists who make a living through major art commissions and sales of their own original art work for \$100 or more, or
- Artists who are participating members of a professional artists' organization, or
- Artists who have had their original art works accepted in 2 or more juried exhibitions. (These exhibitions could include the Iowa Artist's Annual Show, Des Moines Art Festival, Iowa Exhibit at Heritage Gallery, Iowa State Fair, etc.), or
- Artists teaching classes in studio art.

The Non-Professional Artist:

Artists who do not qualify under the above Professional Artist requisites. Exhibiting works at a local bank, store, or Women's Club does not qualify an artist as a professional.

Rules:

Original works may be submitted in two dimensional media: Paintings, drawings, prints, batiks, mixed media, calligraphy and handmade paper art. (Stained glass, photographs, textiles, and sculpture will not be accepted.) Each exhibitor may submit one or two works meeting the following criteria:

- No one entry may be larger than 30 x 37 inches (including frame)
- Each entry must be framed and/or folded canvas edges, and wired for hanging. Clips are not acceptable.
- No art work may be submitted a second time
- Entries must be picked up at the close of the exhibition on Mon., March 8 between 8:30 a.m. & 5:00 p.m.

Entry Data:

There is no fee to enter. No pre-registration is required. When entries are delivered, entry cards must be filled out giving: classification of artist, artist's name, address and telephone number, title of work, medium, its value and whether it is for sale. The Art Exhibition Committee shall act as a selection committee passing on entries which have fulfilled the requirements of the show.

Awards:

Shall be made to outstanding works of art in each category - Professional & Non-Professional: First Prize of \$125, Second Prize of \$100 and Honorable Mention Certificates in both categories.

Purchase Prize:

The Des Moines Women's Club will purchase a Professional piece of art and hang it permanently at Hoyt Sherman Place.

Sales:

Any painting sold during the exhibit will be assessed a fee of 25% of the purchase price by the Des Moines Women's Club.

Insurance:

The Des Moines Women's Club assumes no responsibility for the entries. Every reasonable care will be taken in handling all works submitted, but artists desiring to insure their work must make their own arrangements.
